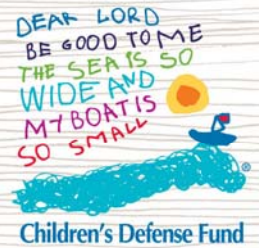

**LETTER OF SUPPORT**

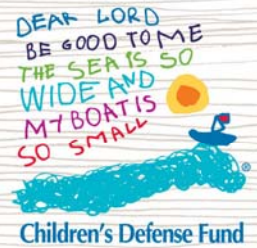
Candidates for the *New Leaders: Joshua and Deborah Generation* track must be committed to the work of a specific religious community. A representative of the religious community must provide a letter of support that indicates 1) how the candidate's training can benefit the larger religious community, 2) how the religious community is committed to supporting the candidate's financial obligations to attend the training, and 3) how the religious community will work with the candidate in fulfilling the joint covenant commitment. If the candidate is applying for a scholarship, the letter of support must further explain the need for financial support.

**COVENANT COMMITMENT**

In fostering intergenerational partnerships, each candidate and their religious community must outline a joint commitment to support child advocacy in their local community. This covenant commitment should simply list at least 5 commitment statements from the candidate and their religious community on addressing child advocacy. Signatures of all involved should be included in the document. During the training, the Joshua and Deborah Generation track will be guided on how to fulfill each of their covenant commitments.
