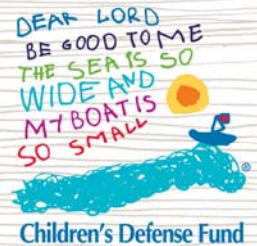

### All Children Need Health Coverage that is Affordable, Comprehensive, and Simple.

#### Health Coverage for Ohio's Children:

- 202,000 children are uninsured (7.0% of all children).\*
- 984,637 children are enrolled in Medicaid.\*\*
- 251,278 children are in the Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP).\*\*\*

#### How affordable is health coverage for Ohio's children?

- Children's eligibility is up to 200 percent of poverty (\$44,100 for a family of four) through Ohio's Medicaid expansion (includes CHIP).

#### How simple are enrollment procedures in CHIP and Medicaid for Ohio's children? †

- Simplification procedures:
  - No face-to-face interview
  - No asset test
  - No waiting period
- Barriers that remain:
  - No 12-month continuous eligibility
  - No presumptive eligibility—which forces children to wait until their application is processed before they can see a doctor
  - No administrative verification of income—the state requires parents to provide proof of income before a child can get health coverage

#### Do children in Ohio's CHIP program receive the same comprehensive benefits as children in Medicaid?

- Yes. Ohio is one of 13 states (plus the District of Columbia) that has used CHIP funding to cover all children eligible for CHIP and Medicaid under one program. As a result, children in CHIP in these states receive the same comprehensive health and mental health coverage (through the Early and Periodic Screening Diagnostic and Treatment (EPSDT) benefit) that all children in Medicaid receive.
