How did your afternoon activities time block serve as an extension of the Integrated Reading Curriculum? What contributions did you make during the Afternoon Activities block? Provide supporting data if possible (e.g., photographs, testimonies, sample lesson plans, etc.)

### **II. Intergenerational Servant Leadership Development**

Reflect on the following quotes from Robert Greenleaf and Ella Baker on servant leadership. Entitle your essay "Ella Baker, Her Vision, and the Freedom Schools Movement." **Do not** detail Ella Baker's biography in this essay.

The servant-leader is servant first... It begins with the natural feeling that one wants to serve, to serve first. Then conscious choice brings one to aspire to lead. He or she is sharply different from the person who is leader first, perhaps because of the need to assuage an unusual power drive or to acquire material possessions. For such it will be a later choice to serve – after leadership is established. The leader-first and the servant-first are two extreme types. Between them there are shadings and blends that are part of the infinite variety of human nature.

The difference manifest itself in the care taken by the servant-first to make sure that other people's highest priority needs are being served. The best test, and difficult to administer, is: do those served grow as persons; do they, while being served, become healthier, wiser, freer, more autonomous, more likely themselves to become servants? And, what is the effect on the least privileged in society; will they benefit, or, at least, will they not be further deprived?
