



2009 Ella Baker Trainer Application Essay/Presentation

The work of an Ella Baker Trainer is very important. As the CDF Freedom Schools[®] program continues to grow, CDF needs a dynamic team in place to facilitate trainings and provide technical assistance to our sponsor partners. The Ella Baker Trainer Team always must work well together, utilizing each other's strengths and challenges to deliver strong, high quality national trainings that empower young adults in communities across the country to operate high quality *CDF Freedom Schools* programs. We seek individuals who know a lot about the *CDF Freedom Schools* program and the reasons behind each element of the program, and who also are able to communicate this knowledge in an engaging and effective manner. It is your task to submit an application essay/presentation to help the selection team appreciate the gifts and talents you would bring to the position.

Your application essay/presentation should follow the guidelines below in order to demonstrate your ability to complete all Ella Baker Trainer responsibilities at a high level of competence and professionalism. Your application also should reflect your knowledge of Mrs. Ella Josephine Baker, the important role of the Ella Baker Trainer to CDF and the *CDF Freedom Schools* program, and the historical significance of the *CDF Freedom Schools* movement.

Include the following components in your Application Essay/Presentation

Describe your understanding of the responsibilities required of an Ella Baker Trainer.

Provide examples of past achievements that demonstrate your ability to serve as an Ella Baker Trainer.

Describe what you will contribute to the Ella Baker Training Team and how you will help ensure the Team's success for the 2009 service year.

Think about the 2009 Ella Baker Child Policy Institute and describe your ideas for your delivery of the Integrated Reading Curriculum, what you would bring to the Teambuilding Initiatives, how you could strengthen Harambee, ways you will promote effective teamwork, and other ideas you have about ensuring a high quality training. Be sure to include examples of strategies and tools you will use to teach the five essential components of the *CDF Freedom Schools* program, your blueprint for classroom setup to ensure intern engagement, ideas to promote higher order thinking skills and non-violent conflict resolution in the classroom, and meaningful social action advocacy. If you have ideas for improving national training, be sure to include them in your discussion with strategies for implementation.

Outline to the Ella Baker Training Team a specific personalized message about the value you will immediately add to the EBT Team. Describe the skills you possess that will add to the success of the EBT Team. Make sure the EBTs (and the selection committee) know what a valuable addition you will be to the team.

If you served as an EBT previously, include a compelling closing statement that describes why you should continue to serve in this capacity.
