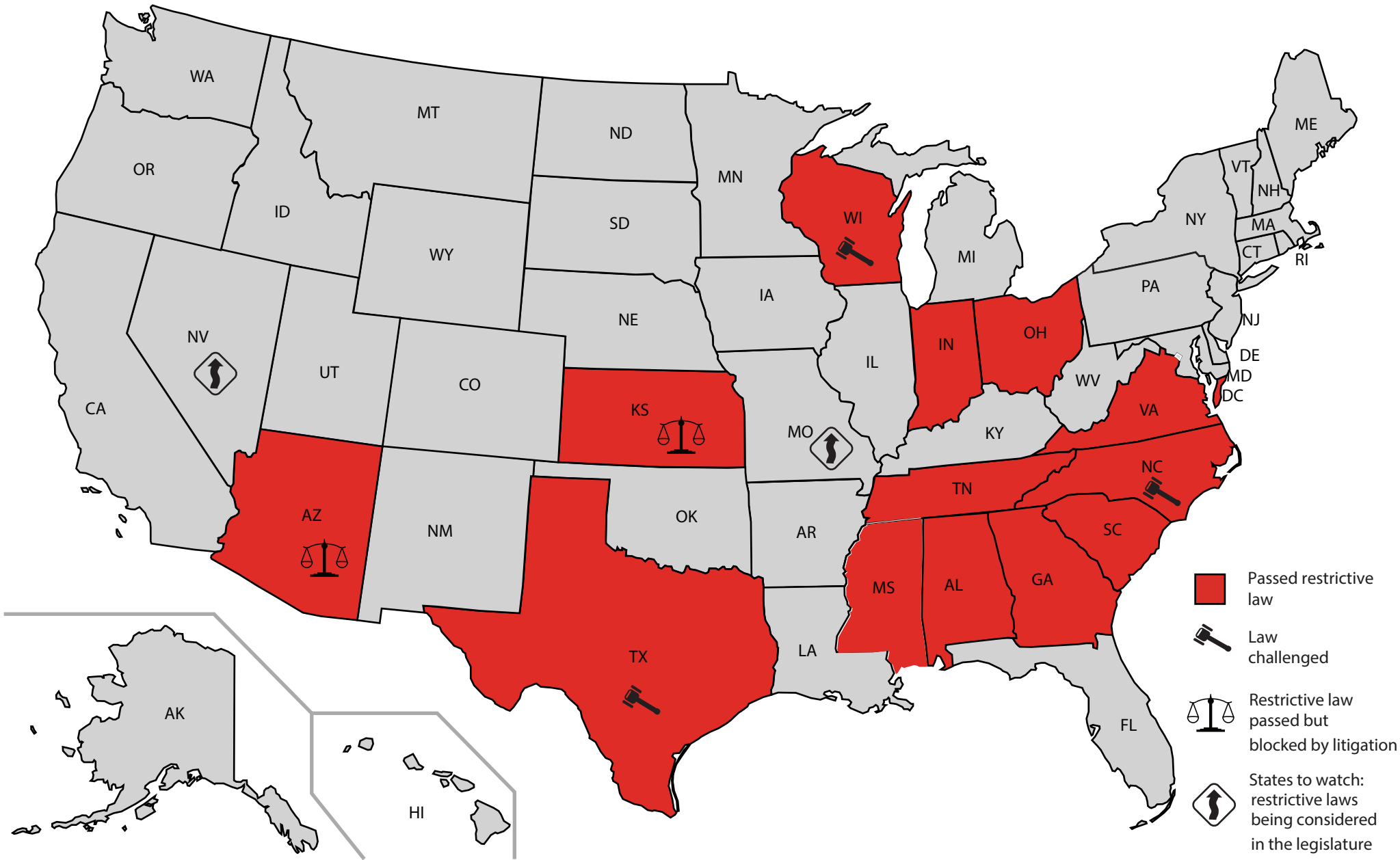


Map of Shame 2015



Map of Shame Index

The states colored red on the Map of Shame indicate states in which restrictive voting laws have passed or are currently in effect, as well as the status of the law in the courts. The map also reflects bills that are being actively considered by that state's legislature or will be on a ballot referendum in 2015. The list does not contain every restrictive bill introduced in 2015.

- AL: Photo ID, Proof of citizenship (in effect)
- AZ: Proof of citizenship (in effect for state voter registration, federal requirement currently blocked by litigation)
- GA: Photo ID (in effect)
- KS: Photo ID (in effect), Proof of citizenship (in effect for state voter registration, federal requirement currently blocked by litigation)
- IN: Photo ID (in effect)
- MO: Photo ID (HJR1 constitutional amendment, SJR5 constitutional amendment, HB30, HB339 and SB170)
- MS: Photo ID (in effect)
- NC: Reduces early voting; eliminates same-day voter registration; and introduces a restrictive photo ID requirement (ID requirement is **not** in effect for 2015; challenged in court)
- NV: Photo ID (SB169)
- OH: Eliminates same-day voter registration (court settlement on 4/17/15 restored the final Sunday of early voting and added early voting weekday evening hours)
- TN: Photo ID (in effect)
- TX: Photo ID (in effect & challenged in court)
- VA: Photo ID (in effect)
- WI: Photo ID (U.S. Supreme Court denied cert. on 3/23/15)
